GENERAL ORDER NO. 4
SERIES 2019-2020

BOSSIER CITY, LOUISIANA
8 April 2019

WHEREAS, Section 259 of the Constitution, Statutes, Disciplinary Rules, Standing Resolutions, Ceremonies, Forms and Approved Decisions of the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar of the United States of America provides that "Each Grand Commandery may at their discretion adopt the [summer uniform]. Further this uniform may only be used for the period beginning with Memorial Day, and continuing through Labor Day."

WHEREAS Grand Master decision 2003, p. 29 & 95, No. 3, Jones provided that "Grand Commanders of each jurisdiction may set the dates for the wearing of summer uniforms in their jurisdictions."

NOW THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Grand Commander of the Grand Commandery of Louisiana, Knights Templar, and pursuant to the laws governing the same:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that summer uniforms are authorized in this Grand Jurisdiction from Memorial Day through Labor Day, inclusive, provided that when appearing in public, the entire Commandery **MUST** be dressed in like manner – either in Regulation Uniform, Cap and Mantle, Summer Uniform, or Ceremonial Uniform.

PROCLAMATION

It is hereby ordered that this General Order be read in open Commandery at the first stated Conclave held after its receipt and the officers and members shall be governed accordingly.
